

Equilore Fire Safety Policy

Equilore is committed to the safety of all staff, volunteers, clients, and visitors and aims to minimise the risk of fire across the site.

Staff and visitors are made aware of the potential fire risks in all areas, including the container-type office and classroom, stables, and storage areas.

All escape routes and access points are kept clear, and flammable materials are stored safely and away from sources of heat. Fire Extinguishers are located by the offices and stables.

Due to the largely outdoor nature of our work as well as working with horses, formal fire alarms and regular drills are not used; however, staff are briefed on emergency procedures and the safest exit routes from the office and enclosed areas.

In the event of a fire, all personnel are responsible for ensuring that anyone in their care is moved to a safe location at a pre-agreed assembly point, and the Director and fire brigade are notified immediately.

Any hazards, damaged equipment, or potential fire risks must be reported promptly so they can be addressed without delay.

This policy is reviewed periodically and updated as necessary to ensure that Equilore maintains a safe environment for all who use the site.
